Advanced notes



Candidates may only enter for **one** of the Advanced entry options per series. A single entry is all that is needed for examination papers, non-exam assessment and certification.

Candidates must be assessed in one British history option (indicated by an asterisk*) and one non-British history option. In addition the following combinations of papers are not permitted:

- 1C cannot be combined with 2C
- 1D cannot be combined with 2F

There is an additional requirement of the Advanced level specification that candidates must cover a chronological range of at least 200 years through the topics assessed in paper 1 + paper 2 + NEA.

If a student wishes to carry forward, they must either re-take the same written exam options as the original attempt, or confirm that the new options still comply with the requirements of the specification (ie there is no overlap of content between the original NEA and the new exam options, and that all three components together cover a chronological range of at least 200 years).

Advanced entry codes

These are generated as follows:

- the first four characters are the Advanced specification code 7042
- the fifth character is the letter that indicates the paper 1 option
- the last character is the letter that indicates the paper 2 option.

The table below shows all the valid combinations of papers and associated Advanced entry codes. An asterisk* indicates a British history option.
