Catch up courses for Years 9, 10 & 12

The lockdown forced many schools to abandon day to day teaching and move towards a 'distance learning' approach. Conversely, at Ealing Independent College, we tried to maintain normality as much as possible within our processes. We stuck to the timetable, successfully covered the syllabus content and were able to maintain our key assessment mock examinations in Easter and June to provide meaningful progress indicators (You could link to my article on 'chasing normality') here. This has meant that disruption in terms of progress within learning for our year 9, 10 and 12 students has been minimised, and they are in a strong position to excel when they return to College after the period of enforced disruption has abated. The College will be offering a Catch Up Programme, available to all students, for the last three weeks in August across the subject areas. Subject specialists will be available to provide differentiated lessons to ensure students are ready for the new challenges which await in September.

Twilight Revision Programme

With a new series of examinations now arranged for October (A Level) and November (GCSE), Ealing Independent College will be offering a twilight revision programme for students who wish to revise key areas of A Level (September) and GCSE (October) courses, providing expert insight on exam techniques strategies to improve your grades.
