### The entry code is 1HI0.

The first digit of the option code is determined by the combination of Paper 1 and Paper 3, while the second is determined by the choice of Paper 2.

For example to combine:

Entry code digit 1

Medicine in Britain, c1250–present/The British sector of the Western Front, 1914–18: injuries, treatment and the trenches

AND

Weimar and Nazi Germany, 1918–39

= first entry code digit F

with:

Entry code digit 2

Superpower relations and the Cold War, 1941–91 AND

Early Elizabethan England, 1558–88

= second entry code digit R

The entry code for this combination would be FR
